### Parking around Schools

Salisbury Council has confirmed that they will be sending parking inspectors out to patrol parking around our school. Andrew Smith Drive in front of the school is a 'No Parking Zone', parents/caregivers who leave their vehicles unattended, could incur a \$92 fine. The 'No Parking Zone' is a drop off only zone.


Life Education wants young people to live safe and healthy lives. Your school has chosen to partner with the team at Life Education to support school based drug and health education.
