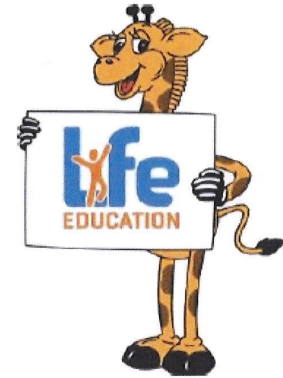

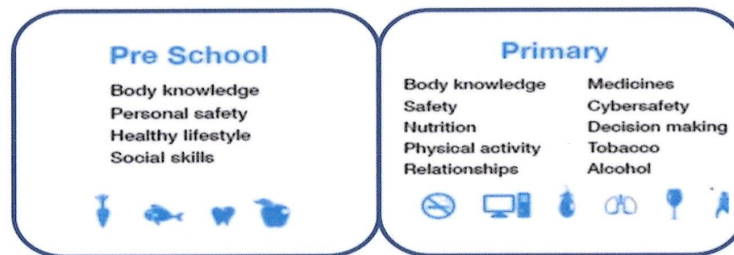

ROOM 29'S BEE INCURSION

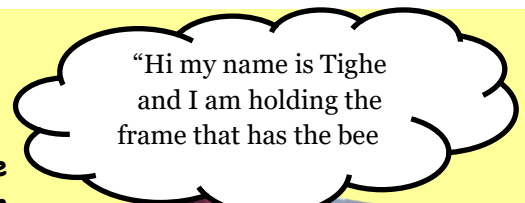


This is Madam (Vanessa) Moizelle Bee, the second generation beekeeper teaching us about bees.
