# Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD)

All schools are required to collect information about the numbers of students that they provide adjustments to under the Disability Discrimination Act (1992) and Disability Standards of Education (2005). From 2018, this data will be used as the basis for national funding.


The NCCD involves the collection of;

- The number of students receiving adjustments to enable them to participate in education on the same basis as other students
- The level of adjustment provided to students
- Student's type of disability if known

Under the model the definition of disability is broad and includes learning difficulties, health and mental health conditions. If you have further questions about the NCCD please feel free to contact

The Pines School has introduced a new method of paying for School and Preschool fees and also the ordering of lunches through the canteen.

It is a free app called 'Qkr' which is downloaded onto your mobile phone. Please note:

- The app will not give you information about how much you owe in fees, you need to check your invoice or contact the school.
- 2018 School fees the full year fee of \$250 is ticked by default but you can nominate "Enter Amount" to pay a different amount.
- 2018 Preschool fees term 2 fees of \$70 is set as default but you can nominate "Enter Amount" to pay a different amount.
- Canteen lunch orders you can pre-order lunches in advance by nominating the date. The cut off time to order lunch on the same day is 9:00am.
