

To support Kickstart for Kids we will be hosting a Happy Day Wheels Day in Week 4 Term 4!! Thursday 14th November will be Reception to Year 3 classes and Friday 15th will be Year 4 to Year 7 classes.

Students are allowed to bring their bike, roller skates, roller blades, skateboards, or scooters to ride. There will be a timetable for the students to ensure safe numbers. Students will not be able to use their wheels without appropriate safety gear. All students bringing their bike must wear a helmet. Students will need knee pads at minimum for all other types of wheels, as well as a helmet. All bikes or other types will need to be put away in the bike shed in the morning.

Students will also be allowed to wear casual clothes on their day.
