

The Premier Reading Challenge has begun and will finish on the 6th September.


Please could you encourage your children to participate.

## 2019 Material & Services Charges

Invoices for school fees will be going home with students this week. A School Card application form has been included for those families who are eligible to apply. Please note School Card application forms must be completed each year and returned to the school as soon as possible for processing.

School Card A application forms can also be submitted online at [www.sa.gov.au](http://www.sa.gov.au)

Payment for school fees may be made by cash, EFPTOS, cheque or via the Qkr app. Instructions for using the Qkr app has also been included with your invoice.

### Qkr is here!

The Pines School has introduced a new method of paying for School and Preschool fees and also the ordering of lunches through the canteen.

It is a free app called 'Qkr' which is downloaded onto your mobile phone. Please note:

The app will not give you information about how much you owe in fees, you need to check your invoice or contact the school.

**2019 School fees** – the full year fee of \$260 is ticked by default but you can nominate "Enter Amount" to pay a different amount.

**2019 Preschool fees** – Term 1 fees of \$70 is set as default but you can nominate "Enter Amount" to pay a different amount.

**Canteen lunch orders** – you can pre-order lunches in advance by nominating the date. The cut off time to order lunch on the same day is 9:00am.
